Community Hospital Based Hyperbaric (HBO) Medicine Service announced

Westchester, New York based Mount Vernon Hospital Hyperbaric Medicine Unit has announced the development of a Self-Funded Community Service Program designed to provide at-cost Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBO) for patients referred by participating physicians.

The self-funded and HBO trained physician supervised treatment for Patients seeking HBO to treat Refractory Lyme Disease, Psoriasis Vulgaris, select Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI), Stroke and Sickle Cell Crisis. These indications have responded to HBO treatment.

The Institutional Review Board (IRB) approved program will provide HBO treatments and collect data to document any patient symptoms / outcomes to help determine optimum treatment protocols for each indication. Acceptance in the program is at the sole discretion of the Mount Vernon Hyperbaric Physician Specialist based on their medical exam, treatment history documentation, and Primary Physician referral and participation in the program.
